Your Health care providers at work-2022

In 2022 the physicians of the North Perth Family Health Team provided primary care access from the Fisher Family Primary Care Clinic for approximately 18,000 patients. Emergency room physicians saw over 13,000 patients and our family OB clinicians saw over 880 appointments with expectant mothers and delivered approximately 131 babies at our Hospital. Our surgical program performed 1400 procedures while there were approximately 6,200 visits to various visiting physician specialists right here at home.

LMHF again received a generous grant from the "Wilma & Bill Harper Foundation", in memory of "Scott Harper, 1955-1972".

The continued support from this grant has supported several pieces of Capital equipment for the Listowel Memorial Hospital.
